Discussed the Southworth property on Penniman road and it's wetlands violations. A stop work order has been issued by DES, which is being ignored by the property owners.

Approved minutes of September 9, 2010 meeting.

Reviewed the request from G. Sandmann to amend the conservation easement for the Walker/Brunori property on Sanborn Road in Plainfield, New Hampshire. The location of the proposed driveway on the current easement would require impacting wetlands and blasting ledge. The history of the property was reviewed and new locations for the driveway were considered. The members unanimously agreed on locating the drive way along the existing stone wall on the edge of the woods. This is the shortest route and will not impact the field.

Two members have recently resigned (M. Gibson and J. Marsh), A. Donaghy and D. Taylor have agreed to become full members. We are looking for alternates to replace them.

Reviewed the plan of work and made a few changes.

Discussed reviving "Green Up Week" in 2011. D. Grobe and A. Donaghy will take the lead on this.
